Feeling isolated and alone in the afterlife, Bloody Mary visits the queen of the underworld to request permission to procure three human females as her own. Believing this request will be beneficial to her own secret agenda, the queen grants Mary her blessing. Now Betty Pearl, Evelyn Grace, and Roselyn Opal must navigate their way through the underworld to find the mirrors they were abducted from and return home.

Bloody Mary marks the first fall performance since CaZo Dance Company's inception that is not a part of CaZo's acclaimed Asylum series. "When I first came up with the concept for Asylum, I thought it would be interesting to showcase a different set of mental illnesses each year," says Borzillo. "It's been a blast watching the show evolve into so much more than that, but I felt it was time to move into something different. Something that wasn't just recognizable to a general audience but something that would scare the pants off of you."

The audience appeal for the legendary myth wasn't the only reason Borzillo chose to bring the story of Bloody Mary to the stage. "When I was a kid, I experienced the story first hand," she says. "My friends and I were in the bathroom, lights off with only a candle and we did the ritual. I swear to this day I saw a shadow of a figure in the mirror. That moment has stuck with me ever since. It's probably the reason I like to explore this darker side of my psyche."
